The minutes of the Thirty sixth Governing Council Meeting held on 24.08.2019 were confirmed as presented in **Annexure - I**.

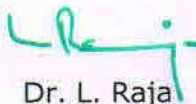
37.2 To review the action taken on the decisions of the Thirty sixth Governing Council Meeting held on 24.08.2019

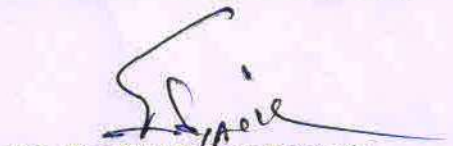
- Ramps and toilets have been extended to buildings other than the main block.

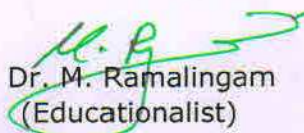

Dr. Patnaik suggested that the college can hire vendors such as TCS - ion for conduct of hassle-free examinations as TCS - ion has proved to be successful in conducting various online examinations. He also enquired about the conduction of arrear examinations, to which Dean Academics confirmed that arrear examinations have not been conducted as instructions are awaited from Anna University. Dr. Patnaik appreciated the college for getting two patents published.

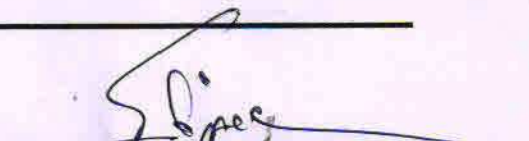

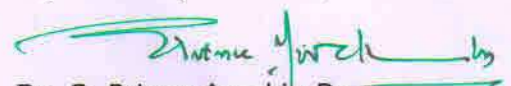

37.4 NBA and NAAC accreditation for the information of the council.

Principal apprised the members that the programmes of BME, CSE and ECE have been accredited for a period of 3 years with effect from 2019 - 20. The Departments of IT and MBA have taken initiatives to apply for NBA during the forthcoming academic year.

Council members emphasized on the urgency to apply for NAAC re-accreditation and asked to speed up the process. Relating to the status of NAAC accreditation, Principal informed the members that the accreditation was valid up to November 14, 2020. He also informed that a team has been formulated and the preparation of SSR is in progress and initial registration will be done in the month of April 2021.

37.11 Presentation of effective handling of online courses during Covid lockdown including Coursera online programs and webinars organised for the information of the council.

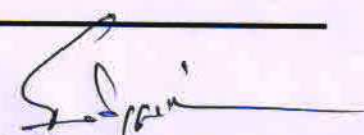

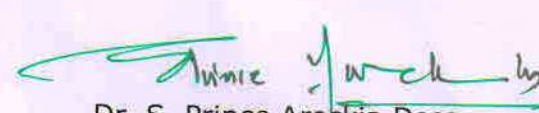

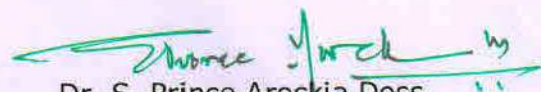

The Principal informed the council that Jerusalem College of Engineering was granted Autonomous status by UGC for a period of 10 years with effect from the academic year 2019 – 2020 to the academic year 2028 – 2029 vide No. F.22-1/2017(AC), dated 29 Apr 2019. He also informed the council that students studying in higher semesters of under graduate (UG) and post graduate (PG) at the time of grant of Autonomous status to the college, shall also be covered under autonomy vide No. F.2-76(41)/2017(AC), dated 30 Apr 2019. Due to the grant of Autonomy, the Principal informed that the Governing Council is reconstituted as per UGC norms. He welcomed all the new members and hoped to look forward to their cooperation and valuable contribution to the deliberations in the meetings of the Governing Council. All the members introduced themselves. The chairman then presented a brief overview of the institution as it has successfully entered into its 25th year and is celebrating the silver jubilee year. He apprised the members about the initiatives taken and progress made by the institution till date. The UGC nominee Dr. Anil Kumar Tripathi expressed happiness to note the achievements of the college. The Anna University nominee Dr. S. K. Patnaik gave a suggestion to include experts from Industry as special invitees in the forthcoming Governing Council meetings.

Students belonging to higher semesters of UG and PG are registered under Anna University, and hence the Regulation, curriculum and syllabi for these students will be followed as per Anna University R2017 for II, III year UG and II year PG students and as per Anna University R2013 for IV year UG students respectively.

The Governing council approved and ratified the same.

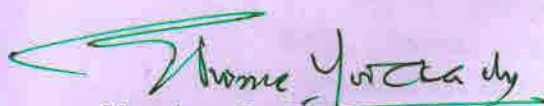
36.12 Presentation of future plans for the information of the council

- Prior procedures of obtaining Course equivalence and due permission from Director, Academic Courses, Anna university and

clearance from AICTE will be obtained before implementation of the program.

- To initiate steps for NAAC accreditation as the present NAAC accreditation expires on November 14, 2020.
