Item No. 2-Approval of Professional elective Syllabus (R2019) offered by Engineering Departments to Engineering students.

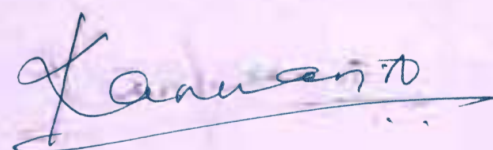
