B.E. CSE (AI & ML) & B.E. CSE(CS) is obtained from Anna University with an intake of 60 each, from the A.Y. 2022-23

- 5. Approvals received for the closure of B.E. CE and M.E. S.E. programmes and for increase in intake in B.Tech. AI & DS programme from 30 to 60 seats.
