- Six sigma design, production and process to be included in operations
- Project management tools to be included
- Dimensions of digital supply chain to be included in Operations
- MSME help for startups to be included in Entrepreneurship Development

Item No. 2 – Approval of syllabi of open electives offered by the Department of Management studies in the 4th semester for the Batch 2019 - 23.



Item No. 1 - Ratification for continuation of Anna University Curriculum and Syllabi for II year students under R2017, Anna University.

The Chairman informed the members that the present II year MBA students admitted under Anna University will continue to follow regulation 2017. As the college has now been granted autonomous status, the Chairman sought approval from the members to continue with the same curriculum and syllabi with the flexibility of conducting examinations (both assessment and End Semester) through the office of Controller of Examinations, Jerusalem College of Engineering. To this, the members accepted to the proposal of the Chairman.

Item No. 2 - Approval of I Year curriculum and Syllabus & II Year, Curriculum (R2019)

The Chairman presented the curriculum for MBA, programme designed for R2019, to be followed from the academic year 2019-20. The presentation started by defining the PEOs, POs, PSOs and their mappings. The curriculum of each semester was discussed in detail and the summary of the number of credits allotted for each category was informed by the Chairman and the same was approved by the members
